


## Park Avenue Apartment

For the renovation of this New York City apartment we took apart the historic apartment plan to create a new open layout based on overlapping spaces. Although the new layout is contemporary, it sits comfortably inside of the building's existing traditional exterior while bringing natural light deep into the interior.

We expressed the building's structure at the ceiling and used design elements including a screen made from borosilicate glass tubes, wood veneer cabinetry, and stone cladding to differentiate the spaces. A lightly stained oak floor, rugs, and furniture tie the spaces together and allow them to overlap.
